The Red Quadrant describes the material's flammability The Blue Quadrant describes the material's health hazard The Yellow Quadrant describes the material's reactivity The White Quadrant optionally provides additional information $OXY = Oxidizer \quad \forall t = Use \text{ No Water } ACID = Acid$ $ALK = Alkali \quad COR = Corrosive$
