

Conducting a Search of a Building

- Discuss duties and communication (3 whistles for emergency)
- Conduct a 360 degree walk around of the building and report findings
- Knock on door and announce yourself
- □ Feel the door (back of hand, bottom to top)
- Mark the wall (1st line and time entering)
- Brace outward opening door with foot while opening
- Prop open door
- Leave a light in the opening
- Call out to announce help, and asking survivors to come to you
- Receive walking wounded at the door
- □ Proper search technique against the wall, systematic plan
- Document: Hazards. Triage victims
- Report findings to Team Lead
- Develop plan to remove victims
- Mark the wall "X" when team leaves structure



Question: When should you move a patient? (Only if the situation is unsafe, or you don't have enough people to have someone stay with them, or better care is available elsewhere)

The search should be systematic. Make a decision. Right turns or left turns only.
