## **RADIO TIPS**

- Plan your very succinct message
- <u>Turn on</u>. <u>Correct channel?</u> <u>Listen before transmitting</u>, to ensure the channel is clear.
- Hold radio upright & parallel to cheek. Antenna upright.
- Press push-to-talk button (PTT), and hold it down while speaking.
   Take a breath 1<sup>st</sup> -a quick pause to allow for transmission to occur.
- Speak clearly; not too fast:
  - 1. First identify who you're calling, by their role/ station name, then ID yourself by role/ station name: (E.g., "Operations, this is Search Team Bravo")
  - Let go of PTT, to allow response. A beep will sound to indicate availability for the next speaker. (With some radios without an automatic beep, saying "Over" indicates handoff to next speaker).
  - 3. Summarize content of what you heard; or Say "Copy". Then add any comment.
  - 4. **Say** your station name, then 'Out' (e.g., "**Search Team Bravo Out")** to indicate finish of your communication. 2<sup>nd</sup> party may also say "**Operations Out**", to indicate the end

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<u>"Stand by"</u> = wait
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<u>"Say again"</u> = repeat

<u>"Break!"</u> (&/or "**Priority Message!**") = to interrupt for urgent use of a channel.

All other parties then immediately relinquish channel.

"Roger" = confirming message, acknowledging that you will follow through as needed

## (there are some variations in other jurisdictions)

- <u>Say "I spell"</u> before spelling out a word with the phonetic alphabet. (E.g., say: "Knot- *I spell*: Kilo, November, Oscar, Tango"). Spell out every proper name.
- <u>Say "figures"</u> before saying numbers. <u>Say each Number digit separately</u>: E.g., say: "Figures: 4, 2, 3, 6 Main Street". (not "forty-two, thirty-six")
- <u>"Decimal"</u> = dot
