



# Public Safety Volunteer Logistics

**Staging** is located next to Sunnyvale's Mobile Emergency Operations Center (MEOC), which will be parked at the corner of Taaffe St and McKinley Ave in downtown Sunnyvale.

The closest **parking** to the staging area is Cityline parking garage #1 ("Pear") and the Target parking garage. Enter either one on Taaffe St between McKinley Ave and Iowa Ave.

ARES volunteers may use the county resource net to track your arrival. (Required if you want credential credit for the event.) Stay on the resource net until you are checked in at staging (not just until you park).

## What to Wear:

- Sunnyvale volunteers: wear your DPS-issued volunteer photo ID on a lanyard.  
Others: if you have an equivalent from your city, please wear it.
- CERT volunteers: wear your green CERT vest.  
ARES volunteers: wear your lime green ARES vest.
- Wear sturdy, closed-toe shoes.
- Do not wear clothing with images or slogans that would make any guest feel unwelcome.
- Casual and comfortable clothing is welcome (e.g., short-sleeved shirts, jeans, khaki shorts, etc.), but please avoid excessively informal clothing (e.g., sleeveless shirts, athletic shorts).
- The weather is expected to be sunny and warm. Wear a hat and sunscreen.

## What to Bring (CERT Volunteers)

- *Fully charged* cell phone with WhatsApp (for location tracking)
- Optional: first aid kit in backpack or fanny pack

## What to Bring (ARES Volunteers)

- HT programmed with the frequencies on the ICS-205
- Batteries for your HT that will last your whole shift
- Headset for your HT (strongly recommended)
- Clipboard with ICS-214 and ICS-309 forms and blank paper
- Non-Sunnyvale volunteers: completed and signed Sunnyvale DSW form

**Lunch** will be provided in the staff tent at the time designated on your schedule.

## Paperwork:

- Everyone needs to sign in and sign out at Staging.
- ARES volunteers should maintain the usual ICS-214 and ICS-309 forms and turn them in when you leave. (Required if you want credential credit for the event.) (No ICS-309 needed from shadows.)
